### PACKING SUGGESTIONS FOR STAFF

When packing, think "enough for 8-10 days." Our laundry service collects once a week and delivers two days later. **Please label all items** that come to camp using nametags or a waterproof marker. There will be an opportunity during pre-season to shop at Walmart for supplies.

## **BEDDING** / **LINENS** (we will provide bedding and a pillow for *international* staff)

2 (yes, two!) Sets of sheets and pillowcases (twin or cot)

Pillow(s)

2-3 warm blankets (ex: wool, fleece, comforter)

2-3 bath/beach towels

# **CLOTHING** (staff members receive a Pemi polo shirt and t-shirt)

6-8 T-Shirts

4 Shorts

2 Jeans/Sweatpants

1 Khakis pants or other slacks for weekly Sunday Meeting and special banquets

1 Collared shirt (polo and/or button, to have in addition to your staff polo shirt)

Socks / Underwear (more than you think you'll need; include 2-3 pairs of wool socks for hiking)

1 Tie (you never know, and it doesn't take up much space)

1 Heavy synthetic fleece top or jacket (or heavyweight wool sweater)

Jacket/Sweatshirt (NH gets cold on some summer nights)

Raincoat

2-3 Bathing suits

Hats (baseball cap style for sun; wool/winter for mountain trips)

# **FOOTWEAR**

Casual footwear (sandals, sneakers)

Hiking Shoes/Boots (athletic shoes with high-traction soles will do)

Athletic specific (cleats, tennis shoes with smooth soles for courts, etc)

### **EQUIPMENT**

Any necessary athletic equipment - Shin guards, baseball glove, etc

Any necessary musical instruments and Music

Sleeping bag

Flashlight/Headlamp

Water Bottle(s)

Backpack for day trips

Toilet Articles, including biodegradable soap and shampoo (many brands are available;

Dr. Bronner's, Tom's of Maine, Burt's Bees, etc)

Shower caddy or other carrier with the capacity to drain, for carrying toiletries

Sunscreen/Sunglasses

Books (for yourself as well as a few to read aloud to your campers)

Laptop Computer and charger (extremely helpful to cabin counselors for writing camper reports)

Stamps and envelopes in plastic bag (for humidity)

Alarm Clock/Clock Radio/Speakers for IPod/Music

Personal mug (for use in Mess Hall for coffee / tea. Generic mugs are always available)

#### FOR FIRST-TIME PEMI EMPLOYEES
